Position: Seniors & Family Worker (Community Programs)

Cedar Cottage Neighbourhood House is seeking a **Seniors and Family Worker** who is passionate about building connections, strengthening community, and creating meaningful opportunities for seniors and families to thrive. As a key member of our Community Programs Team, you will help shape programs that bring people together, encourage active participation, and support well-being across generations. Your responsibilities will include:

- Program Development:** Designing responsive, culturally informed programs that meet the needs of seniors and families (such as Family Drop Ins, Parenting Workshops, Seniors Meet and Greets)
- Engagement:** Inspiring community members and volunteers to get involved, lead, and contribute to neighbourhood life (such as Seniors Sharing Circles-e.g. knitting, singing)
- Activity Development** Planning and facilitating programs, special events, information and referral supports, and access to community resources (Diwali, Lunar New Year, Orange Shirt Day)
- Community Building:** Supporting seniors and families to enjoy healthy, connected living throughout the Kensington–Cedar Cottage neighbourhood. (Community Gardens, local parks)

Key Requirements:

1. Understanding of the needs, strengths, and diversity of seniors and families in Kensington–Cedar Cottage.
2. Commitment to the principles of prevention, social justice, equity, and systems thinking.
3. Awareness of how income, access, food security, and race intersect and shape program development.
4. Ability to ensure program effectiveness through strong risk management practices and maintaining detailed records and reports for program administration
5. Ability to work as part of a team to collaborate with community partners, funders, and service providers to support seamless and effective program delivery.
6. Ability to contribute to funding proposals and identify new opportunities that support long-term program sustainability.

Qualifications:

- Post secondary work in social work, child and youth care, or a related social science or health field.
- 1-2 years of relevant experience, or a combination of education, training, and experience.
- Experience and knowledge working with children, families and seniors in diverse cultural settings.
- Strong communication (written and oral), relationship-building, and program coordination skills.
